Latasha Brinson is the Site Lead and Senior Manager, Ethics and Business Conduct for the Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Company facility in Marietta, Georgia. She was appointed to her current role in November 2011. She is responsible for site-level leadership of the Ethics and Business Conduct function, as well as providing guidance and advice, and overseeing ethics-related investigations, training and administrative proceedings for the almost 5,000- member workforce. Ms. Brinson has been a Lockheed Martin employee for over 18 years.

Ms. Brinson supports both company and corporate business ethics initiatives and advancing a culture of integrity, while serving as a resource for business area employees in understanding and upholding Lockheed Martin’s continuing commitment to ethical conduct.

Ms. Brinson previously served as the Investigations Manager for the Aeronautics Company’s Marietta Security and Emergency Services organization, with responsibility for directing the conduct of investigations pursuant to violations of company policy, government regulations and criminal law. Additionally, her organization managed both counterintelligence and workplace violence programs; performed employment suitability checks; non-employee background investigations; and provided executive protection and event security. Ms. Brinson’s duties included extensive engagement and liaison with local, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

Prior to joining Aeronautics, Ms. Brinson was both a Special Agent and Undercover Narcotics Agent with the Georgia Bureau of Investigation (GBI) and a Certified Georgia Peace Officer. Her duties included performing a wide range of investigative activities and assisting in the prosecution of criminal cases in the Georgia court system.

Ms. Brinson is an active community volunteer and has served on numerous boards and advisory board positions with several organizations. Ms. Brinson currently serves on the Board of Directors for both the Atlanta Compliance and Ethics (ACE) Roundtable and Cool Girls, Inc.
